Fewer babies are being born in Lambeth hospitals



42% decrease in the Lambeth fertility rate between 2011-2021*

More than one in five pregnant women booked onto maternity services late



Two thirds of women now self refer onto maternity services for their antenatal care



Demographics & Risk Factors



The average age of pregnant women was **32** in the LEAP area and **31** across Lambeth

Maternity services see a more diverse group of women from the LEAP area compared with the rest of Lambeth

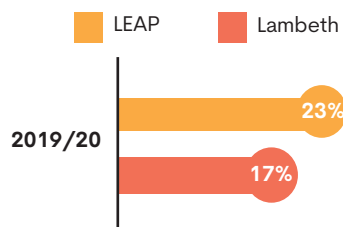
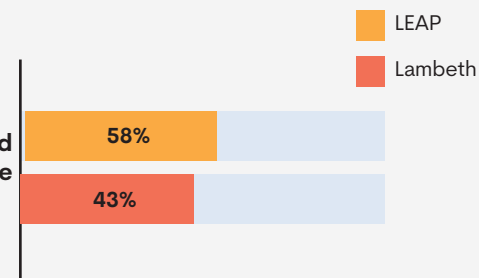
Women whose first language was not English:

26% from Lambeth

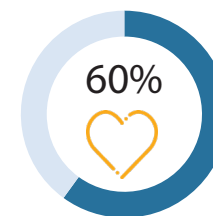
Ethnicity reported as non-White



6 out of 10 pregnant women presented with at least one medical risk factor in 2019/20 (both LEAP and Lambeth-wide)



Women from the LEAP area had a **greater proportion** of social risk factors in 2018/19 & 2019/20 than women from the whole of Lambeth



The proportion of women who were not or could not be asked about current domestic abuse **increased** in 2019/20 (both LEAP and Lambeth-wide)
